The Client

During construction of their new high school, the administrators recognized a need for a storage solution that would conserve space in the school's new library.

The area causing concern was the limited space allotted for the storage of the library's reference materials and the lack of space for future growth of the collection.

In order to maximize the usage of the available space, a flexible, high density storage system was needed.

Storage Solution

After a review of the library floor plan and assessment of the available storage space, a MobileTrak5® system was designed to fit into the area.

The 4Post™ shelving on the system allowed for flexibility with the shelf spacing and options, as well as the use of dividers to separate sections.
